## HOW TO GET IN

### PLACEMENT EXAM

### DECLARING THE CERTIFICATE

Declaring the certificate is as easy as meeting with the undergraduate advisor and making an appointment to review requirements and discuss course plans on Starfish (<https://wisc.starfishsolutions.com/starfish-ops/dl/instructor/serviceCatalog.html?bookmark=connection/10715/schedule>). Students may declare the certificate at any point in their language study.

Students declared in the Chinese major are not eligible to declare the Chinese Professional Communication certificate.
