# EUROPEAN STUDIES, CERTIFICATE

The European Studies Program (https://europe.wisc.edu/), in cooperation with the Center for European Studies, the Jean Monnet European Union Center of Excellence (JMEUCE), and the DAAD Center for German and European Studies (CGES), promotes knowledge and understanding of Europe both on and off campus. Established in 1968, the program provides integrated interdisciplinary studies on contemporary Europe for both undergraduate and graduate students. The program brings together scholars on campus interested in different aspects of Europe to discuss topics of mutual interest. More than 30 departments offer courses on Europe (excluding language courses), providing the largest number of courses on any region of the world other than the United States.
