

COUNSELING PSYCHOLOGY, DOCTORAL MINOR

ADMISSIONS

Ph.D. students wishing to complete a Ph.D. minor in Counseling Psychology should complete their program's minor form, listing four graduate courses in Counseling Psychology that they wish to take (or have already taken). If the student has selected a faculty member from the Counseling Psychology faculty to be their minor advisor, the form should be signed by them. If no specific faculty member has been selected, the form may be turned in to the student services coordinator in room 335B, who will then forward the request to the chair for approval. Following the signature of the CP minor advisor or department chair, the student should then get the signature of their home department advisor. The completed form with all signatures must then be given to the CP student services coordinator, who will maintain a copy in the CP files.
