

CLINICAL AND HEALTH INFORMATICS, CAPSTONE CERTIFICATE

This 9-credit online certificate provides students with an interdisciplinary approach to develop innovative solutions and improve current practices in healthcare operations, decision-making, policy, clinical practice, biomedical and health information systems, and data security.

Based in UW-Madison's Institute for Clinical and Translation Research, this certificate is designed as an academic springboard to meet the growing workforce demand for informaticists. This 9-credit program can be completed in one year, to promptly serve professionals for clinical or information technology-related work in the healthcare industry. Coursework stacks directly into a MS program in Clinical & Health Informatics for learners who want to continue for a graduate degree.
