

# AGRICULTURAL & APPLIED ECONOMICS THEMATIC TRACK

The Agricultural and Applied Economics Department (<https://visp.wisc.edu/thematic-aae/>) invites international students to take courses within their department.

Students can choose to enter the general cohort or one of the concentration areas: Quantitative and Applied Economics (QAE), International Development (ID), or Food Industry Management (FIM). Each concentration area has field-specific course offerings with a targeted plan of next steps.
