

MECHANICAL ENGINEERING THEMATIC TRACK

Participants in the Mechanical Engineering Visiting International Student Program (<https://visp.wisc.edu/thematic-me/>) are guaranteed enrollment in a cohesive set of senior-level courses in the department. Additionally, students have access to the entire College of Engineering course catalog to put together a program that meets their needs.

VISP participants who successfully complete an academic year in this program and receive a grade of B or better in classes have the option to apply for preferred admission to the accelerated Master of Science in Mechanical Engineering (<https://guide.wisc.edu/graduate/mechanical-engineering/mechanical-engineering-ms/mechanical-engineering-acelerated-program-ms/>) degree program.

Participants must meet the VISP eligibility criteria (<https://visp.wisc.edu/eligibility/>) for admission into this program. Applicants to this thematic track should have at least completed their junior or senior level in a mechanical engineering curriculum. This thematic track admits students at the undergraduate, graduate, or dissertator level (<https://visp.wisc.edu/fulltime/>).

Students can participate in the fall and/or spring semester as well as in the summer term.
