

# STATISTICS THEMATIC TRACK

The Department of Statistics (<https://visp.wisc.edu/thematic-stat/>) invites international students to take a variety of courses in statistics and data science. Students will have a mix of coursework including a core set of courses for 15 credits and a choice of electives.

After their first year as a nondegree visiting student, VISP students have the option to apply to continue their studies in the MS Statistics: Statistics and Data Science graduate degree program (<https://stat.wisc.edu/graduate-studies/data-science-option/>). Those intending to apply may be able to take some of the MS Statistics: Statistics and Data Science course requirements as a VISP student. However, admission to the graduate program is a separate admissions process and is not to be considered a guaranteed element of the VISP thematic track program offering. Participants must start in the fall term and stay for an academic year.
