## STATISTICS THEMATIC TRACK

The Department of Statistics (https://visp.wisc.edu/thematic-stat/) invites international students to take a variety of courses in statistics and data science. Students will have a mix of coursework including a core set of courses for 15 credits and a choice of electives.

After their first year as a nondegree visiting student, VISP students have the option to apply to continue their studies in the MS Statistics: Statistics and Data Science graduate degree program (https://stat.wisc.edu/graduate-studies/data-science-option/). Those intending to apply may be able to take some of the MS Statistics: Statistics and Data Science course requirements as a VISP student. However, admission to the graduate program is a separate admissions process and is not to be considered a guaranteed element of the VISP thematic track program offering. Participants must meet the VISP eligibility criteria (https://visp.wisc.edu/eligibility/) for admission into this program. Applicants to this thematic track must also have completed the specific coursework listed on the track's webpage (https://visp.wisc.edu/thematic-stat/).

Participants must start in the fall term and stay for an academic year.
