

# GLOBAL CULTURES, LANGUAGES, AND EDUCATION, CERTIFICATE

The Certificate in Global Cultures, Languages, and Education (GCLE) educates students about global anthropological, sociolinguistic, and language policy and planning perspectives, while providing them with tools to think critically about global language, literacy, and sociocultural contexts.

The courses pose key questions about the relationships among cultural diversity, social inequality, and language, and they provide students with skills to work globally, within and beyond schools, in the field of culture, communication, and education.

Graduates of the certificate program will develop an understanding of the fields of international educational development and change and the knowledge to engage in reflexive, culturally-sensitive and sustainable approaches to improving education development policy, practice, and outcomes.
