The global GIS market size is projected to reach \$681 billion in 2025, with an estimated rapid growth rate anticipated post-2025, culminating in a valuation of \$1.44 trillion by 2030. This growth is driven by strategic public policy reforms, industry acceleration strategies, and innovations in AI and data science technologies. In an era dominated by big data, students require expertise in specialized programming languages, technical hardware, and the continuously evolving algorithms, methods, and tools essential for acquiring, processing, utilizing, publishing, and preserving vast volumes of geospatial data. In response, the Geospatial Data Science curriculum helps prepare students to become the next generation of geospatial data scientists and professionals, equipped with essential skills in spatial data analysis, geovisualization, AI, critical thinking, and problem-solving to meet both the needs of industry and academia.
