Requirements	Details
How to get in	No application required. All students who meet the requirements listed below are eligible to declare. For information on how to declare, see Advising & Careers.
Courses required to get in	<p>Students must complete one of the following groups of prerequisite courses prior to declaring the major:</p> <p>Group 1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• GERMAN 249, GERMAN 258, and GERMAN 262</li> </ul> <p>Group 2</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• GERMAN 249 and GERMAN 285</li> </ul>
GPA requirements to get in	None.
Credits required to get in	9 credits of German language coursework at the third-year level (language courses after GERMAN 204).
Other	Third-year German language courses (GERMAN 249, GERMAN 258, GERMAN 262, GERMAN 285) are not sequenced; they may be taken in any order and/or simultaneously.

Students who have completed the prerequisite coursework may declare the German major at any time by consulting with the German program's undergraduate advisor.

Students declared in the German certificate may not be declared in the German major at the same time. Students who do wish to declare this major must first cancel their declaration in the certificate.
